




Science at Avanti Fields

Topics each year will cover biology, chemistry and physics




Science at Avanti Fields

KS4 Science: 2 routes

- 1. Combined Science Trilogy (double science)
- Short topics that cover all 3 science disciplines → 2 GCSE grades (9-1),
- **2. Separate Sciences** (triple award: Biology, Chemistry and Physics)
- Extra content for each topic in all 3 science disciplines → 3 separate GCSE grades (9-1)
- Final linear exams at the end of Y11: 6 papers total
- Longer exams for the separate science route
