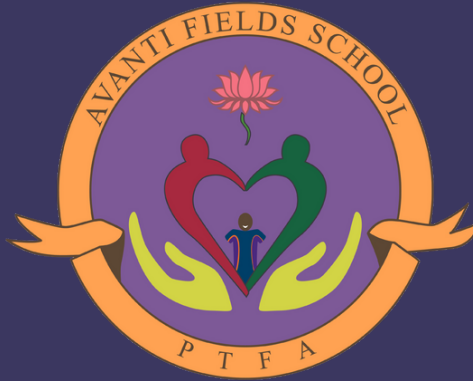

3. Bring your Eventbrite booking confirmation with you for entry.
