



Big Question: Are we all the same?

Writing and fine motor skills

We want all our children to develop their gross and fine motor skills.

Encouraging your child to climb and be active is part of developing their core strength for gross motor. Throwing and catching bean bags and balls, hopping around on one foot and letting your child have a go at pouring their own drink into their cups is all part of their development.

You can have fun with fine motor skill activities at home. Have a go at threading with pasta, rolling and kneading playdough. Cutting, following lines with scissors.

Reading:

Reading is such an important part of your child's development. Reading daily to your child as well as singing nursery rhymes are crucial for your child's development in communication and language and literacy. Reading stories and exploring sounds through song and rhyme can help your child differentiate between sounds, understand what a story is and increase their vocabulary.
