Dear families,

Online Learning:

I write to you to reiterate the communication you received earlier that our remote learning programme begins tomorrow for pupils. AGS pupils are expected to complete the minimum expectation of 3 hours of learning each day, in line with guidance set out by the Department for Education to all schools.

The school will be in contact with families tomorrow (06.01.21) to arrange logistics for providing IT equipment to those who may critically require it, prioritising those pupils with additional needs.

Free School Meals:

This week, AGS will continue to hand deliver free school meals to those who require and will communicate how we intend to provide FSM thereafter.

Reporting results:

Until 07.01.21, families who are now absent from school must inform AGS of positive results via the school office email.

Critical Worker and Vulnerable pupil attendance:

The CWV pupils that we have in school will be taught by teaching and support staff on a rota. Pupils will be bubbled by Key stage whilst they are in the school building to allow for the implementation of proportionate track and trace measures.

The AGS team have worked hard over the past day and night to ensure that all pupils remain safe and able to access learning. I trust that our plans for remote learning will allow all pupils to make positive progress throughout the national lockdown.

I continue to wish all families good health and to thank you for the continued support for keeping our school community safe and learning.
