Covid Risk Assessment Update:

Dear families,

I am writing to direct your attention to our updated Risk Assessment which can now be found on our website. Due to the rising cases of COVID-19 in Bristol we must tighten some of the previously relaxed measures. We've taken advice from Bristol City Council and SW Public Health England on how best to minimise transmission and keep our community as safe as possible.

The key changes, which we hope to be in place for a short while until case numbers drop, are that Teachers and TAs will remain in separate class bubbles. We are reissuing procedures so that staff remain contained to bubble contacts only. This is so we minimise the risk of closing numerous bubbles in the case of a positive case.

The impact of this in the short term is that Spanish and Recovery Reading Intervention will be paused or delivered in an alternative way until we can return to the measures from our last risk assessment.

Many thanks again to all families for the patience in these difficult circumstances. The school feels well supported to do our best to keep the community safe and learning.
