Key achievements to date:	Areas for further improvement and baseline evidence of need:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Employment of Sports Coaches (Sporting Chance) to Avanti Gardens to teach engaging and consistent P.E lessons.• Implementation of a unique P.E curriculum that compliments the facilities, grounds and National Curriculum requirements at Avanti Gardens.• Avanti Gardens have invested in a great deal of Sports equipment meaning that a wider range of Sports can be accessed for all children.• Yoga provision provides a quiet meditation time for all Avanti Gardens pupils.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Time invested in developing the professional development of the coaching team. This will require some time given to upskilling Sports staff so they are aware and can implement the school's pedagogical approaches, thus improving the teaching and learning of lessons.• Continued development of raising the profile of PE and physical activity within and outside of school – the further roll out of after school sporting clubs in 2022 to include basketball, football (in KS2), Athletics and Circus/Gymnastics.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimming provision at KS2 has begun. We will record the number of children achieving the national expectation of swimming 25m at the end of KS2. Engagement of all pupils: the pupils at Avanti Gardens are all highly engaged and motivated by sport and physical education lessons- most of whom have not participated in National Curriculum P.E before. Lunchtime Sports provision (offered via a Sporting Chance coach) has improved outside behaviour Tuesday through to Friday. SEN sports group also set up for once a week. High Profile of PE & Sport – pupil achievements are celebrated weekly in the bulletin, as well as through house points and planned Summer Sporting events. Broad Experiences – Our pupils are given access to a great variety of sports in the Primary curriculum. The curriculum has been redeveloped around the needs of our children and in line with NC to ensure that they are given the skills and experiences needed for sport. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adding to the bullet point above: Development of more extra-curricular clubs to maximise participation, engagement and levels of uptake in a wide variety of sports.
