Dear Parents and Carers,

We are moving very quickly to the end of the academic year. Over the course of this term, advice and guidance over what schools can do has change significantly, but it appears now we are in a more stable position to understand what September will look and feel like for Avanti Hall School. I will write nearer the time confirming this, but I am looking forward to moving the school back to a normal settled environment.

It would be at this time of year where we would hold an induction for new students joining the school. Due to the current situation, we have left the final decision until later in the term in order to make sure that this is a viable thing to do. Now I can confirm that we will be having an induction period for our year 6 students, and their peers who will be joining us in September. In order to do this under current guidelines, will be changing our final week plans as follows.

Year 1 and Reception Bubbles will have their last day on Tuesday 14th July.

Year 10 will be in school on Monday 13th and Tuesday 14th of July.

Year 6 will not be in on the Monday and Tuesday, but will come into school on Thursday 16th and Friday 17th for the induction days. We will hold an enhanced transition day on Wednesday 15th.

Our Key worker and Vulnerable bubbles will continue throughout, but in-line with national guidance will not be operating through the summer holidays.
