Reports

As this year comes to an end it is important to celebrate all of the achievements your child has made, both in and out of the classroom. Sadly, like the last academic year, each phase has faced disruption due to the ongoing pandemic, but thanks to the dedication of the staff team and the great support from you at home, we are confident that learning was not impacted too detrimentally.
