Dear parents and carers of Yew Class,

We are delighted to be offering Forest School lessons at Avanti Hall.

Your child had their first Forest School lesson this week, where they started thinking about safety and what a forest school session might look like.

**Yew class will have their Forest School lesson on a Tuesday every week.**

We will spend each lesson in the woods and around the school site. We will be outside for the lesson duration even if the weather is wet/cold so children need to have appropriate clothing.

They will need to wear:

**A waterproof coat**

**Waterproof trousers** (warm, old trousers that can get wet/muddy would be an acceptable alternative)

**Wellies** (walking boots or even old trainers would be an alternative)

The children can leave these items at school in a named bag on their peg or bring them home each week following their lesson. The children will be wearing their school uniform underneath their waterproofs.
