What are EDINGLY Openers?

EDINGLY Openers consist of words ending in -ED, -ING and -LY. We all know them and most of us use them, but do we use them enough as openers? Adverbs (words often ending in -LY), are fantastic at providing a quick opener for a sentence, as are the Verbs (words often ending in -ED or -ING). Below are some examples of each as well as those EDINGLY words that can be used together to make your sentences even more effective. All you need to remember is to use a comma after the opener.
