Summer Term 2 Week 5 - Laughing Ladybirds and Busy Bees

Below is a general list of our focus learning, please take the time to work on these areas and encourage your child to work as independently as possible. As per the EYFS curriculum, activities below can be play based. Children can carry out activities independently or with adult direction. Please upload all home learning on EExAT; for multiple photographs please upload as a photo collage.

- Home learning activities will be similar to what is being taught in school.
- There will be no more Zoom sessions as staff will be at school.
- We will not be able to check EExAT uploads as frequently as usual, however we will endeavour to acknowledge and provide feedback as much as we can.
- Please see homework below (daily work); children attending school can complete this after school each day; pupils at home can complete it any time during the day.

This week is Art Week; we will be creating an art project based on similarities and differences

Week 5 of new topic<mark>: As a result of recent events around the world, we will be exploring similarities and differences between people. We will make explicit links to our Avanti Values (Respect/ Empathy) and the British Values (Mutual Respect). Based on our topic, we will create a final art project as a class to show our learning and understanding.</mark>

<u>Topic: main lessons/activities:</u>

- Please go through the Topic PPT. We have created daily lessons with a main activity for each day.
- PPT slides will also include a plenary for each day, this is something you can do after the main activity as a summary.
- PPT slides also include links to stories and videos.
- Thursday and Friday; we would like you to use as a recap day and it is an opportunity for you to complete your art project.
- Details of the art project will also be on the slides.
- Children coming to school will complete the project at school, however they are more than welcome to create their own at home.

- These are the same slides that we will be using at school, therefore all children will be accessing the same learning content.

<u>Literacy/Phonics</u>: We will be recapping many of the sounds and tricky words to consolidate learning and address misconceptions, with a focus on assessing any gaps in learning. We understand that many of the sounds will be repeated, however this is to ensure that we can build on their phonic knowledge and secure their learning.

Below we have combined Green group and Blue group's phonics as this how we will continue teaching for the rest of the term. A challenge will be provided for children who need to be extended.
