## We Are All Different Talk Cards Answers

1. The girl's hair is blonde and curly.
2. The boy likes to eat bananas.
3. The boy likes the rain.
4. Child's own response. (Encourage children to look at pictures from the book for some ideas, if needed.)
5. One girl likes to eat apples, the other girl likes to eat grapes.
6. One girl has a pet cat, the other has a pet goldfish. One has straight blonde hair and the other has curly ginger hair. One has freckles and the other doesn't.
7. One boy speaks Portuguese, the other communicates using sign language.
8. Child's own response. (Prompt children to think about some of the differences shown in the book, e.g. hair type or interests.)
9. The girl likes to play music, the boy likes to write.
10. One family has a mum and a dad and a little girl, the other family has a grandpa and a little boy. One family enjoys baking together, the other likes singing. Both families have fun together. (Accept any other similarities and differences that make sense.)
11. The story teaches us that everyone is different and that it is good to have friends who look different to us and like different things.
