I have included rhetorical questions.	
I have included subordinate clauses using some of these conjunctions (but, before, while, until, despite, even though, after, because, as, since, although).	
I have included relative embedded clauses using some of these relative pronouns (who, that, whom, whose, which).	
I have used dashes, brackets and commas correctly for parenthesis.	
I have written some short sentences for dramatic effect.	
I have included some 'show not tell' sentences.	
I have used a thesaurus to up level some of my vocabulary with different synonyms.	
I have written it in old fashioned English as if it is from that era.
