Vooks

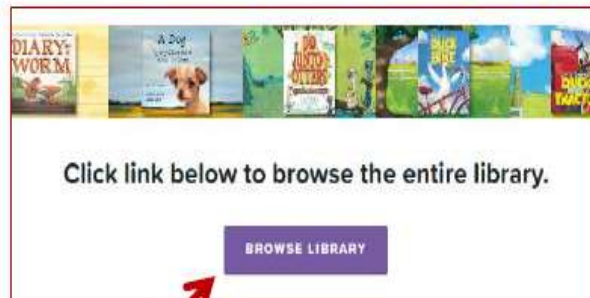
All pupils

<p>Phonics Play</p> <p>EYFS and KS1</p>	<p>Supports phonics skills: blending and segmenting.</p>	<p>Get to the website using the link https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/freeIndex.htm</p> <p>Log in using the free log in details</p> <p>Username: march20 Password: home</p> <p>Then press the LOG IN button</p>  <p>Click on the CHILDREN blue bubble then GAMES purple bubble</p>  <p>Select phase 3, 4 or 5 from the tabs on the side</p>  <p>Select a game and enjoy. *Most used ones in school are buried treasure and picnic on Pluto but feel free to enjoy all the games!*</p>

<p>Oxford Owl</p> <p>EYFS and KS1</p>	<p>A website with 100 free eBooks</p> <p>You will need to sign up and create an account for free access to the eBooks.</p>	<p>Get to the website using the link https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page/</p> <p>You will now be at the ebook library.</p>  <p>When you select a book it will ask you to log in or register. You can create a free account to access these books.</p>
<p>Big Cat Reading books</p> <p>EYFS and KS1</p>	<p>Access to a range of colour banded books.</p> <p>Please encourage your child to read books that are matched to his/her reading level, as advised by the class teacher.</p> <p>Free access expires on 31st July.</p>	<p>Get to the website using the link https://connect.collins.co.uk/school/portal.aspx</p> <p>Find this part of the page (on a computer top right, on a tablet or mobile it should be there straight away)</p> <p>Click on teacher sign in</p>  <p>Username: parents@harpercollins.co.uk Password: Parents20! Click on their band to filter the selection to appropriate reading material.</p> </div> </div> <p>Then simply click on the front cover of a book of your child's choice to open it. Most of the books will automatically read it out loud to your child.</p> <p>It will highlight the words that are being said so your child can track them. It will make a noise when you need to turn the page. Simply click on the next picture at the bottom of the screen to get to the next page.</p>
