<u>Literacy/ Phonics</u>: We will be recapping many of the sounds and tricky words to consolidate learning and address misconceptions, with a focus on assessing any gaps in learning. We understand that many of the sounds will be repeated, however this is to ensure that we can build on their phonic knowledge and secure their learning. Below we have combined Green group and Blue group's phonics as this how we will continue teaching for the rest of the term. A challenge will be provided for children who need to be extended.

Vocabulary: corners/sides/flat/3d/2d/round/pointy/faces/edges

Please follow the lessons on the 3d shapes PPT. There will be main activities on the PPT. Below are further ideas that you can do with your child.

Activities:

- Go on a 2d shape hunt
- Go on a 3d shape hunt
- Sort shapes into 2d and 3d/ Sort shapes into different sections/ parts
- Match everyday objects to the 2d and 3d shapes
- Draw around shapes and label sides/ corners/ faces
- Create your own shape flower
- Use 3d shapes or objects to create something. Can you identify what shapes you have used?
- Spots shapes from pictures
- Make shapes with playdough

- How many lines of symmetry can you draw on a 2d shape?

Yoga: Zoom session Tuesdays at 11am

PE: Set up:

- Create a circuit, with chalk bubbles (2m meters apart).
- Chn to do the warmup in a circle, within the bubbles.
- Each bubble to have a shape or instruction inside of it.
- Music player

Main Activity:

- When the music plays you run/jump/ walk to the next bubble (always adhering to the 2m distance).
- When the music stops chn to pose in the shape/ carrying out the instruction set in their circle.
