

Muhammad Ali was a famous boxer. He was a good role-model because he did what he thought was right. He also refused to join the



American Army, even when his boxing medals



were taken from him. Ali was able to win his championship status back and many people think he is the greatest boxer of all time.





Nelson Mandela was a black man who stood up for the equal rights of everyone, not based on the colour of their skin. In 1964, he was sentenced to life imprisonment because of his

beliefs. 26 years later, he was released from prison and eventually became the first black South African President in



1994. How inspiring he is for never giving up!

It is important to remember events that have happened in the past so that we can make the world a better place. By celebrating these people during Black History Month, we are making sure that no-one is treated differently because of the colour of their skin.




