

Black History Month Homework: Windrush Puppet Making (due Monday 12.10.20)

Next week, we will start to learn about Black History month, with a focus on the journeys of the HMT ship, Empire Windrush, that began around 1948.

We would like you to create puppets representing someone from the black community during the time of Windrush. This can be a 2 week project, which will result in some of you performing **puppet shows** in our classrooms for our peers using the puppets you make.

You can use wooden spoons, socks, wool, recycling materials, card, felt, etc. to make the puppets. You may want to research about men, women, children of Windrush and look at some pictures first. Decide which one you want to make and dress them in the fashion style of the 1940's. Don't forget to include props for your puppets like hats, bags etc.
