
Word bank Moses Jew Rules


The Torah includes stories told by someone special. His name was Moses. He was sent by God to spread the word of God . He also created 10 rules that Jews had to follow. This is called the 10 Commandments.

I will tell you the story of Moses. You can use your puppets to tell the story.



When Moses was born, his people were slaves in Egypt.

A priest told the Pharaoh that a special boy would be born and he would become the new King of his people. The Pharaoh was afraid of them because he thought they might take over his country. He did not like this (Pretend to be Pharaoh and show me your angry face)

To save Moses, his mother made a plan. She put him in a basket and set him adrift on the River Nile and prayed that God would watch over him. (lets pretend to be his mum and pray for his safety)

Moses floated down the river where the Pharaoh's daughter found and rescued him. She brought him back to the palace and looked after him as a son. As Moses grew up he thought he was the Prince.

Moses grew up in the palace as a royal prince. One day he went out and saw that the people were being treated unfairly. They were forced to work with out food and water. This upset Moses very much. (How would you feel if you saw others being treated unfairly? What could you do to help?)



So Moses gave up the palace and decided not to be the Prince anymore. He wanted to help his people. *Can you remember another story about a Prince? He also left the palace to help others. Who was it?* Date: Wednesday

Moses worked as a shepherd for forty years. One day, in the desert, he heard the voice of God from a burning bush.



God asked Moses to lead his people out of slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land (rescue them).



Moses went back to Egypt and asked the Pharaoh to free his people. The Pharaoh laughed and said no!




God was angry and tried to scare Pharaoh by sending down 10 plagues.


Each time Moses asked Pharaoh to set his people and each time he said no!







Work with your partner/ adult to think of your own rules. How can we ensure that we are good people? How can we care for others? What does Respect mean to you?




