# Moses

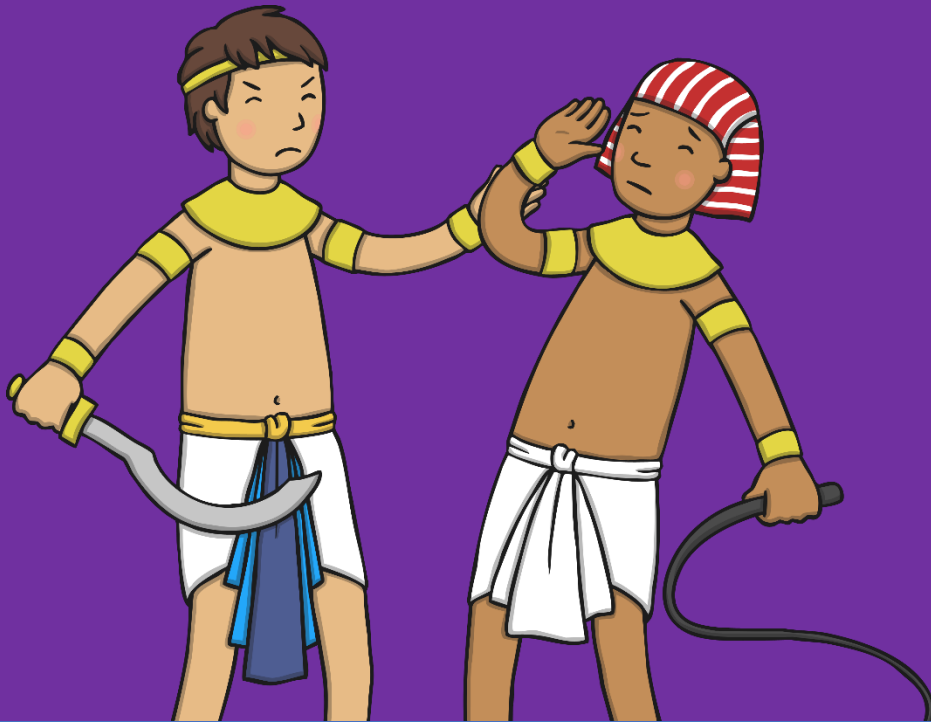

God asked Moses to lead his people out of slavery in Egypt to the Promised Land (rescue them).

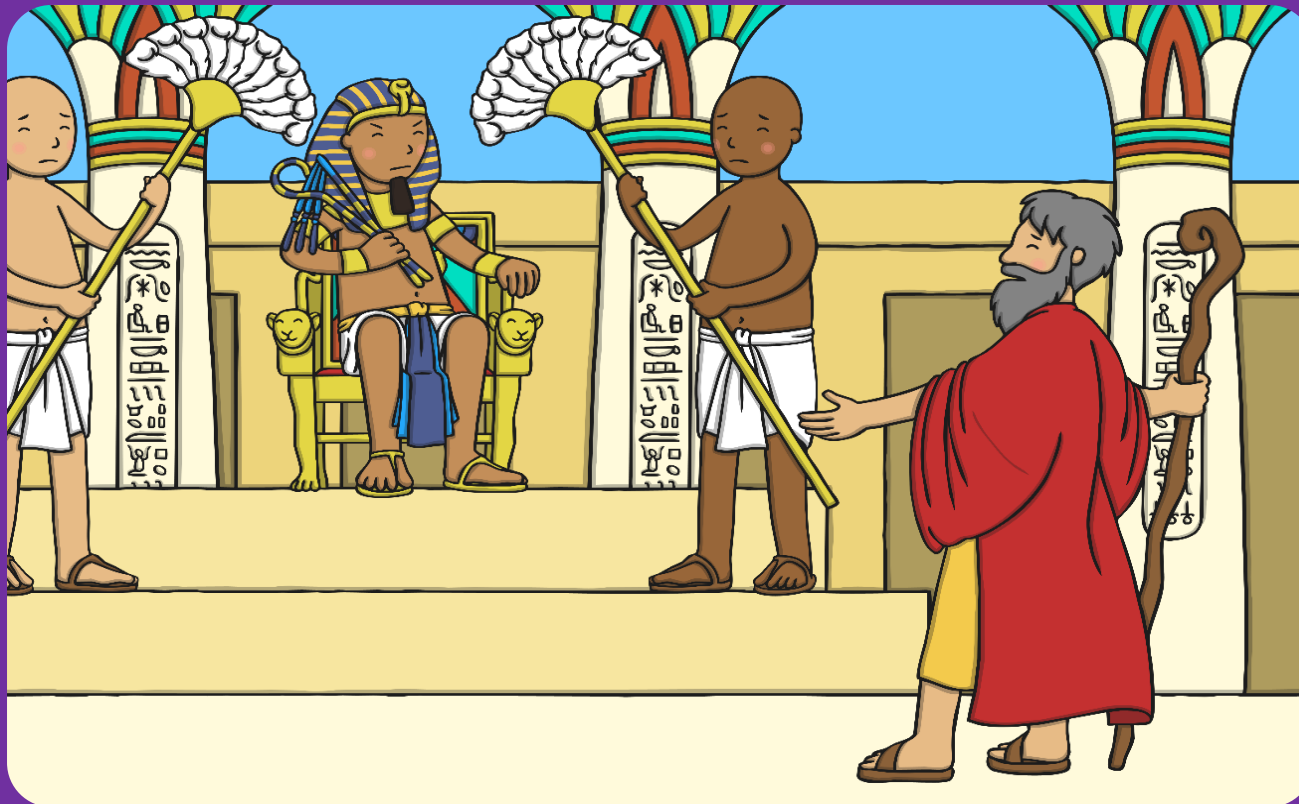

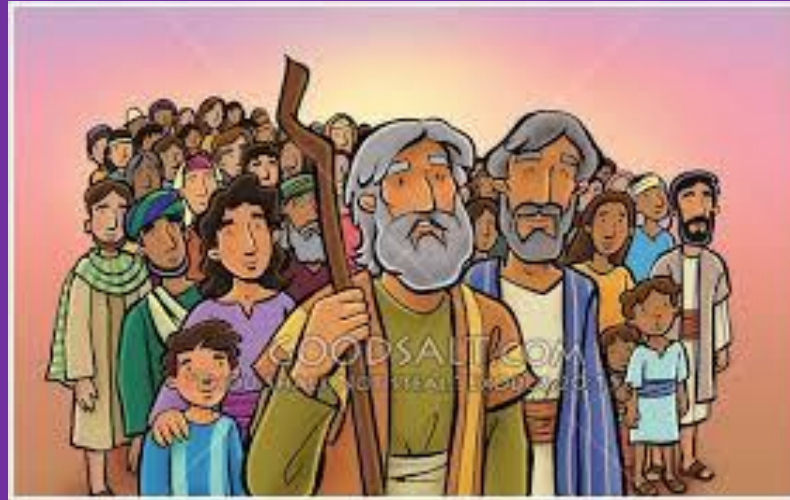

God told Moses to lift up his rod and as he did so the waters parted to make a dry path.

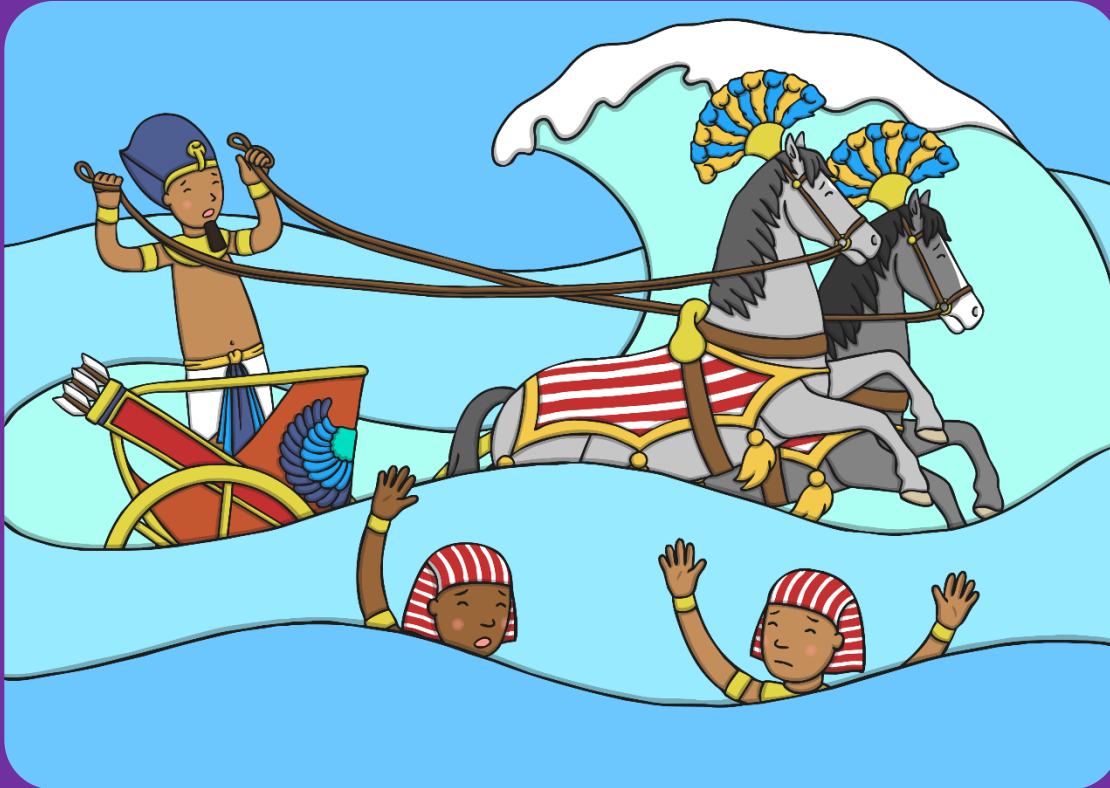

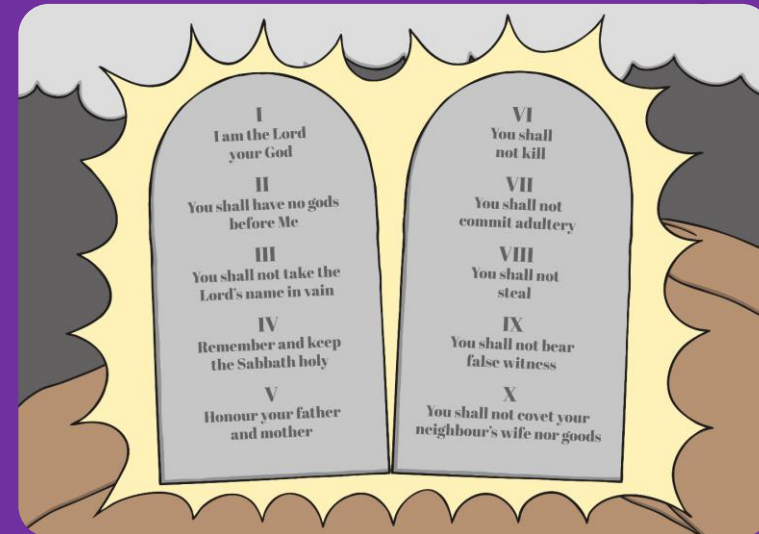

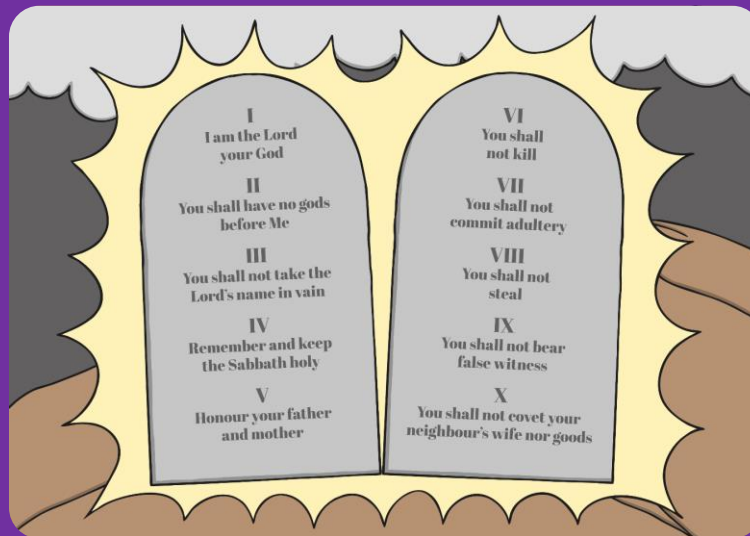
