

Reception Autumn 2 Week 3 Learning Menu – Laughing Ladybirds and Busy Bees

Below is a general overview of activities for the week. Parents can use these ideas or activities to enhance home learning. We will endeavour to upload different activities and ideas each week based on our ‘topic’ learning. If your child is leaving early with their older sibling, they can also try the below activities at home. This can be used as ‘homework’ but this is not compulsory. EYFS will only begin to set compulsory homework in spring term (January onwards). If your child does complete/engage in any of the below activities, these do not need to be ‘handed in’, however you are more than welcome to start uploading evidence of their learning on Tapestry. If you are unsure of how to access Tapestry please ask class teachers, we will attempt to help you any way we can. Use the below as a ‘menu’ of learning; pick and choose what your child would like to do. Remember to keep learning fun, active and hands on! Be as creative as possible!

Topic focus: Festivals and Celebrations

Phonics: phase 2 sounds – o, c, k, ck (digraph – two letters that make 1 sound) HFW: and	Maths: Spatial awareness & Circles and Triangles	Topic: Buddhism & Birthday

As you find the objects, describe the position of the objects (the toy is under the box)</i> • <i>Describe 2D shapes. How many corners/ sides does it have.</i> • <i>Go on a shape a hunt around your house. Can find a circle or triangle?</i> • <i>Create your own triangle and circle picture (See Kadinsky Art)</i> • Vocab: round/ corners/ sides/ 2D/ flat In front/ behind/ on top/ next/ under/ inside/ beside/ in between 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Watch how people celebrate Wesak – make simple comparisons</i> • <i>Create a picture of how you celebrate your birthday.</i> • <i>Try to make the different religious symbols. You could paint them or use different media</i> • <i>Practise meditation – how does it make you feel? Why is meditation important</i> <p>Vocab: respect/ faith/ Buddhism/ Wat/ meditation/ Wesak/ celebrate</p>
