#### Further ideas to do at home:

- Practice writing the sound in flour/ slime (other sensory materials)

- Sort sounds (have 2 different sets of sounds)
- Match pictures or objects to the sound

- Read simple P words and match to the object or picture
- Use magnetic letters to make simple words or fill in the first sound
- Practice forming the letter correctly
