Phonics:


We would like you to practice phase 4 polysyllabic words – these are two words making one. Two separate documents has been uploaded with words that can be put into sentences developing further understanding through application.

Comprehension:

Please encourage your child to answer the questions in full sentences and not one-word answers. For example:

Q: Who was the bad character in the story?

A: The bad character in the story was... 

A: The wolf. 

Please remind your child sentences do not begin with 'because' and to remember their punctuation capital letters, full stops.

Christmas Project:

Following our recovery curriculum and to encourage children to build their confidence, we would like you to create a short video (1-2 minutes) of your child discussing what they are doing in the Christmas holidays and how it links to our school values/virtues i.e. respect, courage, kindness, compassion.

These will be strictly confidential between the year 1 team and will be shared with the classes in the first week back.

Maths:

In autumn term, we have covered these concepts; shapes, place value (numbers to 10) and addition subtraction (numbers to and within 10). Please encourage your child to build on their number facts knowledge and all the strategies that we have learnt so far, for example: number line, part whole model, Ten Frame etc.

It will be helpful to recite 2s, 5s and 10s-times tables as well as number bonds to 10.
