I recently heard a podcast by Edward Anobah (Instagram @edanobah) who is an expert in training and developing leaders, where he and his wife were reflecting on being 'present' and shared the following poignant musing: 'Being present is having an understanding of acceptance; being centred and balanced. It is about having a space of balance in the moment, not feeling under pressure by what has happened in the past but having the opportunity to soak in what is happening now. Being present provides a space where we can be more grounded, giving us resilience to deal with things in a more healthy and anchored way.' At a time where there is much uncertainty thus leading to heightened anxiety and stress, let us take out sometime to reflect on these wise words and considerations for our own lives.

Pupil Premium Provision

Once a year we provide the department for education with information that we hold about our pupils in a census return. Allocations are made based on the school which the eligible pupil attends at the time of the January school census. This information is used to determine the amount of additional funding we receive for specific pupils, and we then ensure the money is spent on those same pupils over the course of the school year. The Pupil Premium is additional funding given to schools so that we can support our disadvantaged pupils and close the attainment gap between them and their peers.

The most common reason a pupil receives Pupil Premium funding at our school is because a parent is registered as receiving a benefit that entitles them to free school meals. This is not the same as receiving a free school meal as all children in EYFS – Year 2 are currently receiving.

To find out if you qualify for the Pupil Premium Grant, please use the eligibility checker by visiting <u>http://fsm.lgfl.net</u>. Once you have accessed the website, you will be able to quickly and easily check if you are entitled. It gives you an immediate "yes" or "no" response and may notify the school. IF YOUR CHILD WAS ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS LAST YEAR, YOU MUST STILL RE – APPLY USING THE ABOVE WEBSITE.
