








What story have we been focusing on for National Storytelling Week?












Can you guess what character everyone is? You can give clues by acting like them, dressing like them or talking like them.


















Have you got any work that you would like to show us? It could be your written work, it could be some acting or creative work - we can only spend a few min looking at everyone's
