

Wednesday One More Activity Sheet – optional worksheet (you can choose which parts to do or have a go at it all)

Task:

Provide children with their own number line.

- Practise simple one more sums using a number line
- Adult can give children different sums to solve using the number line (one more than... $1+1=$
- Extend your child by giving them word problems, see if they can show their reasoning using the number line



1 more than 0 is	$0+1=$
1 more than 1 is	$1+1=$
1 more than 2 is	$2+1=$
1 more than 3 is	$3+1=$
1 more than 4 is	$4+1=$
1 more than 5 is	$5+1=$
	Can you spot the pattern?
