Teachers will also be using the feedback grid below to provide summative feedback to the whole-class. This will be posted on Google Classroom and discussed with the class once per week. By doing so children are able to both collaboratively and individually reflect on their learning and discuss as a group the next steps – addressing any misconceptions that have occurred.

Key Terms Explained:
