Mocks: Firstly I would like to say a massive well done to the year 11s who have worked so hard over the last fortnight during their mock exams, it has been an incredibly intense couple of weeks and they have managed to keep up their spirits and give it their best shot, so well done!!

Thanks also to all the teachers, TAs, support staff and volunteers who have helped out with invigilation, we couldn't have done it without you!

Religious Studies Teacher: It is with regret that I have to let you know that Gabriella has moved on but we have found a replacement RS teacher who has also been an examiner for Religious Studies with experience teaching A-Level. Her name is Liz Barrett and we will be welcoming her in after Easter. Liz will be well placed to support the students get the grades they deserve as she has a good knowledge of what examiners are looking for.

GCSEs: The exam boards have released new assessment material for each subject and teachers will be reviewing these over the Easter and we will be using these in class to build up more evidence for the Centre Assessed Grades. Teachers will make it very clear which activities will be counted in the evidence for Centre Assessed Grades and will be preparing the pupils for each assessment as they move forward.

She is called Kurshid Normanhomed and we will be welcoming her after Easter for a handover.
