

## Internet safety

### Teach Computing Coverage

Year	Unit	
Y1	Technology around us	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will be introduced to the concept of using computers safely, within the context of a school setting. They will explore why we have rules in school and how those rules help us, and then apply this understanding to rules needed for using computer technology safely.</li> </ul>
Y2	I.T. around us	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will consider how they use different forms of information technology safely, in a range of different environments.</li> <li>➤ Learners will think about the choices that are made when using information technology, and the responsibility associated with those choices.</li> </ul>
Y4	The Internet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will gain an appreciation of the fact that not everything they see on the internet is true, honest, or accurate. They will review images and decide they may not be real, before conducting a web search which will return ambiguous and sometimes misleading results, looking for why this is the case.</li> </ul>
Y5	Sharing information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will take part in a collaborative online project with other class members and develop their skills in working together online.</li> </ul>
Y6	Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will explore issues around privacy and information security.</li> </ul>
Y6	Web page creation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Learners will consider the implications of linking to content owned by other people and create hyperlinks on their own websites that link to other people's work</li> </ul>
Y7	Collaborating online respectfully	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ In this unit learners will discuss appropriate use of the school network, and receive an update and reminder of important online safety issues. In terms of online safety, this unit focuses on respecting others online, spotting strangers, and the effects of cyberbullying.</li> </ul>
