HEADLICE:

We have had reports of cases of head lice in multiple classes .The eradication of head lice is a community issue, and so, to that end, can I please ask all of you to check your children for head lice, and to condition and comb every three days for the next two weeks if lice or eggs are found.

The school nurse informed the school that only adult head lice can move from head to head and that head lice take five days to reach maturity.

The NHS page will talk you through 'wet combing' to eradication; by thorough combing with conditioner every three days we can be certain that no lice are being passed from

head to head. If you have tried that already for 17 days, to seek advice from a pharmacist.
