Dear Parents and Carers,

Sustainable travel is something that is very important to us here at Avanti Park and we want the children to be able to make safe and active journeys to school. Over the past couple of years, we have worked alongside Frome Town Council on various active travel initiatives including a virtual walk to Poland, Mojo Moves and Bicycle powered fun days, along with national initiative such as the Big Walk and Wheel. These have been very popular with the children and many of them do walk/scoot/cycle to school. However, there are still issues over how safe this is in terms of air quality and also danger from moving traffic. Frome Town council has been working closely with Sustrans Home - Sustrans.org.uk to create a detailed plan for creating safer routes to school in our part of Frome. There have been many consultations along the way (you may remember them running a pop-up information tent a while back), particularly with the schools in our area. I am really pleased to be able to welcome Emma Parker (FTC and one of our parents!) to

our school, who will be leading a meeting next Wednesday (25th) at 5pm. She will be explaining what is going to be put in place locally to make our journeys to school safer and active! She will be sharing the final plans, final timings and will be able to answer any questions that you might have.
