

## **CLUB BOOKING INFO**

All clubs run by outside providers need to be booked directly with those providers (contact details are provided in this Newsletter) The club leader will then contact the school with a list of participants – payment is directly to the club and by booking a place you agree to give permission for the club leader to collect your child and take them to the club (usually from the school library)

Any free clubs are bookable via the Arbor App under Clubs, except the school Choir which needs to be booked via the school office.

## **WRAPAROUND CARE BOOKING INFO**

Booking will open at 9.00 a.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sept to give the new families joining the school a chance to book in when the new academic year starts.

There are four bookable slots:

- 1) Morning wraparound care club – 7.45 – 8.45 ~ £4.00
- 2) Full wraparound care after school club – 15:15 – 17:00 ~ £7.00
- 3) Shorter wraparound after school club – 15.15 – 16.15 ~ £4.00
- 4) End session wraparound care 16.15 – 17.00 ~ £3.00

There will be 30 places available in the morning and the afternoon so please book early to avoid disappointment – payment is via Arbor and booking will only be possible if your account is in credit.

## **SAFEGUARDING**

All club leaders check with our attendance officer before the start of each session to see which children are off sick that day but if, for any reason, your child is unable to attend a club after school it is essential that you let the club leader know that they won't be attending that day – if you cannot get hold of the club leader, please ensure you have contacted the school office.
