This week we celebrated the very important festival of Ramnavmi. Lord Rama appeared on this planet millions of years ago in Ayodhya, India, and His appearance is celebrated on this day. Lord Rama's tragic life - the losing of His kingdom, His wife Sita's kidnapping, and the inevitable war against Her kidnapper Ravana who was King of Lanka - is depicted in the ancient epic scripture called the "Ramayana" - a famous literature read across all Hindu traditions. Lord Rama is known for His

adherence to dharma (duty) through all situations He faced and is celebrated as the ideal devotee, king, and husband.

The Children had a great time working in teams to re-create some of the pastimes from the Ramayana using props, drama skills and speaking and listening

They had the oppurtunity to explore how Lord Rama showed all the Avanti Values and then decided on a pastime that embedded a particular value. They then worked in groups to create a play that showed the pastime.
