Reception

The week the children have had a fantastic time learning about Sharks after listening to the story of 'Shark in the Park. 'In Literacy, they wrote speech bubbles after thinking about what the character, Timothy Pope would say when he saw a shark in the park whilst looking through his telescope. The children's work was outstanding. In Maths, we learnt about, Prepositions or directions. The children enjoyed playing a game to investigate different positional language. We designed our own Park and thought about giving directions around the park. Finally, the children enjoyed making their own telescopes and looking through them at different objects.

Year 1

In Maths we have been adding and subtracting tens from a 2-digit numbers and exploring strategies to add and subtract 2-digit numbers. In English we have been learning to understand noun phrases and use extended noun phrases for description. In Science we have been learning about what hibernation and migration are. In History, we have been exploring different castles in around the UK.

Year 2

This week we finished our English topic around quest stories by writing our very own quest stories, using our own characters, settings, and obstacles to overcome. In maths we started a new topic Measurement: Capacity & Volume. Children have been weighing different objects around the classroom using non-standard units to measure the weight of the objects. For our topic sensational journeys, we went on a safari to a national park in Kenya - we spotted lots of animals, including the Big 5! The year 2 children have created their own National Park and used a compas rose, key and instructions to show the route on how to spot as many animals as possible! In science we learned all about how we use energy and what renewable energy is. The children get very involved and share with great enthusiasm when they have reduced their impact on the environment. A great week of learning!

Year 3

This week we have been busy rehearsing the fantastic Ratha Yatra play. We are working very hard to put up the best performance for our families and peers.

In Maths we kept on learning about measurement. We learned how to measure, compare, add and subtract capacity and volume of different containers. Then, we used our knowledge to solve some word problems! In English, we started writing our exciting story of a child going back to the Iron Age!

Year 4

The learning in English this week has been very pupil led. Based on the children's incredible and imaginative mythical creatures created in our Greek Day, children have planned and begun to write an exciting mythical story with their own creature as the protagonist. Children were encouraged to explore the structure of a quest story plot and then planned for all the different aspects of their story. Keeping the reader in mind, children have begun to write their opening and build up focusing on reader engagement through various literary devices and grammatical techniques. In Maths, we completed our learning on the properties of shape and have now started learning about position and direction. We started off the learning by creating our own quadrants on the playground with chalk to describe position to our friends.
