Please be aware that we will not be selling the uniform. The school does not keep any stock of uniforms. Also note Brigade limited, supplier of the school uniform is extremely busy in August, therefore, we would recommend purchasing compulsory uniform items in advance to ensure your child is prepared for the 2021/22 Academic Year.
