# What is EExAT?

---

EExAT or the Early Excellence Assessment Tracker is a programme the Avanti Schools Trust has bought into for their EYFS year groups.

It assesses children in 6 month bands against their actual age so a child who is born in August is not being graded the same as a child born in September who is nearly an entire year older than them.



What did you sign for when you arrived?

You have signed for you child's unique login code. All the codes are different and only give you access to your child's learning.


# Access: How to get it

Please follow this very simple login process:


1. Go to the following website:

2. Click on the button that says, 'register as a parent'

# Access: How to get it

---

3. Add you details, this includes but is not limited to, your email address, name and a password of your choice
4. Add your child's unique code (it is attached to the letter)
5. Press Register

# Access: How to get it

6. Then login to your account
7. Once logged in, an account page will appear, you do not need to add any details, just scroll to the bottom and press accept
8. You are now logged in 😊
9. You are on the 'Dashboard' page, you can scroll down to see work your child's teacher has released to you.

# Access: What you can do

---

You can:

- See some of your child's learning
- Comment on your child's learning
- Upload learning from home



# Access: What you can do

## Parents

---

- **Can parents access their child's learning journal? Can they download and print this?**
  - Yes they can. Parents will be given an access code by their child's teacher/key person and this will need to be activated by the parent by registering on [www.eexat.com](http://www.eexat.com). The system will then allow parents to view, add to and print their child's learning journal.
- **Can parents amend/edit my comments or tagged statements?**
  - Parents cannot edit a teacher's information but can add their own comments.
- **Can parents add an observation and tag this to a statement?**
  - EExAT will allow a parent to submit evidence [video, image, note/observation] to the school/setting. It is up to the school/setting to decide how to use the parents' submissions. You will receive a notification when a parent has sent evidence to you and when they have commented on their child's Learning Journal. You may choose to tag the evidence to a statement and include this in the Learning Journal or file this with the child's evidence.
