## **Community Garden Project Award**

Wonderful news! We have been granted £10,000 for a community garden project at the school from the Big Lottery Fund.

This project will be for the school and community, providing space that is inclusive and a stimulating environment for children to share new experiences, overcome barriers and develop confidence. The fund will specifically fund sessional workers, plants, paving, sand, soil, leaflets and promotion.

The project is to be completed before the end of the calendar year .We will keep you updated with progress and opening dates.

Cost is £39 for 6 sessions – paid directly to them. It is for Years 1-4. The club will run straight after school from 2.55 to 3.55, parents to pick up children at 4pm from school.

Payments for 2<sup>nd</sup> half Spring Term, for lunch and bus payments are now overdue. Please make your payments promptly.

Changes to Parentpay: when you log-in you may be prompted to change your user name to a verified email address, and then to verify this. Please follow the instructions otherwise you may be unable to access your Parentpay account.



## School drop off & pick up reminders:

- School gates open at 7.35 am
  - All children to be in school by 8am
- School gates will close by 8.00am. Thereafter parents need to accompany and sign in children at reception
- 2.45pm is the afternoon pick up time no cars are allowed in the grounds unless authorised. Parents arriving late to pick up children will be issued with a letter, on the third letter they will be fined – this is to cover the cost of staff giving child care
- Please always use the pedestrian gates to walk in and exit for you and your child's safety - do not use the car exit as a pedestrian entry or exit.
