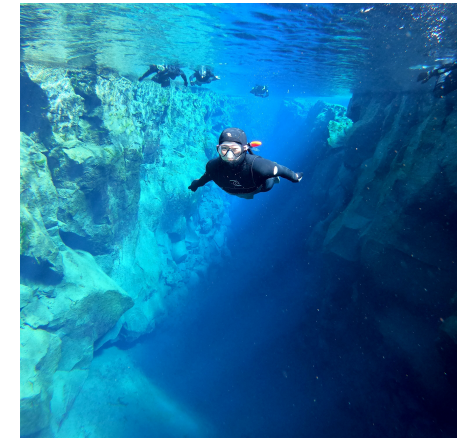
On this day in...
