On this day in...

(yesterday actually) in 1565, the 'Treaty of Cebu' was signed between Miguel López de Legazpi (an explorer of Spanish descent) and monarch Rajah Tupas of Cebu. It resulted in a situation of **Suzerainty** in Spain. Suzerainty is the right of a country to partly control another.
