On this day in...

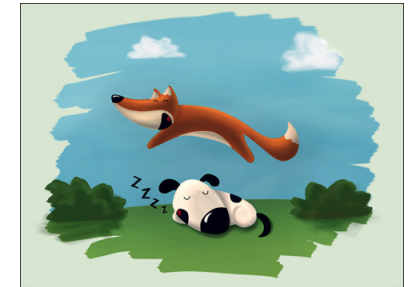
1761, the Coronation of King George III of the United Kingdom and Queen Charlotte took place.
