We are currently getting quotes into widening the path into school as we understand it is narrow. Please bear with us at the current time as you will appreciate the length of path takes a substantial budget which we are working on - we are also looking to have the path lit for the darker nights.

We have a good team of staff who care very much about the children and we all totally understand we are part of a team working together for your children; parents too are part of that team. We want you to approach us and let us know what is good and what could be improved; this is how we get better.

I've moved my son to Krishna avanti this year. He came from another school and was really struggling. In a space of a few months he is striving at your school - I wished we had moved him earlier but still glad we moved him. The school and especially Mrs Chohan has believed in him and the sports and opportunities he's had in the few months he has been here has been more than all the 5 years at another school had given him. Thank you Krishna avanti ??

You are very welcome. We talk a lot about opportunities including the sports which are so important for all of the children. We hope of her opportunities help also such as the arts, science and technology.

I feel, where my child is not meeting the expected level, the class interventions should be in place quickly. As a parent, i had to request this a few times before it was identified and in place. Also, maybe more communication with parents, where children need that extra support.

Also, the homework i feel is appropriate for their age but not for their ability. Where my child is still needing that extra support, some of the homework is difficult or challenge to complete.

Thank you for raising this and we would expect that any form of provision is in place as quickly as possible. We hope that with the daily communications before and after school, the termly reports, and the contact page of the website give ample opportunity for communication between school staff and parents. Work in school should be differentiated to meet the needs of the child wherever they are. Homework however is currently the same for all children so that parents can be quite clear as to how your child is getting on for a child of their age. In more extreme cases, different homework is set.

I feel that the school does not communicate with the parents very well. If there is an a day where the child has to dress up you only gives us a couple of days notice. You have to understand that alot of the parents work full time.

We recognise that there have been some events where you had little notice and for this we apologise. We would like to give as much notice as possible and whilst it isn't an excuse, the busyness of school and numerous opportunities does result in some messages going out a little late - again apologies. There are some occasions where opportunities arise quite late which do result in late notice; we would rather do this than decline an invitation to take part in something.

I am strongly agree with all answer my daughter is so happy and excited to come to school she said i am enjoying at school meeting new friends and her teacher and food is lovely she is enjoying at Krishna avanti.

Though I feel the school is great, one of the biggest problems for my child is school dinners. She comes home from school most days very hungry as she has not enjoyed her lunch. I know it is impossible to cater for every child's taste buns but I know she is not a fussy eater and tends to give things a try but is unhappy with the meals.

We try to encourage all of the children to eat and try things that they either haven't tried before or in the case of fussy eaters, are fussy about. The portions children receive are appropriate, which may on occasion conflict with portions they receive elsewhere. Homework set for Foundation Two is all about experiences in life and taking part with things. As stated on the website regarding homework, if you feel you have done enough then stop. We do not expect the children to work on homework all week.

So many of the staff give up their time voluntarily to run after-school clubs I appreciate for those that work to sort childcare out can be an issue but please appreciate schools are not childminders.

Parking around school is very difficult and we continue to ask our parents to respect the local residents. We do talk to the highways regarding roads and pathways which are beyond our jurisdiction.

Thank you for letting us know about external providers and please continue to do so if ever it happens at the time. We will always check the quality of external providers and let them know about the ethos as appropriate, in clubs that they offer.

If a concern has not been dealt with please do let the Principal know. We are very keen to ensure we deal with even the smallest of concern straight away so that no issue becomes bigger than it needs to be. By having stuff available before and after school, and the contacts page on the website, we want to know about any issue so that we can deal with it instantly where possible and certainly within a matter of days where we need to look into things. We also aim to feedback to what we find to ensure that everybody understands, learns and is satisfied at the conclusion of the incident.

Teachers are not communicating with parents efficiently as to how an child is performing at, school. I feel as homework is not enough for a child. I feel it's minimum homework.

Please see the comment about homework above. Some parents want a lot of homework and some parents want very little, if any; we try to give a reasonable amount but not anything that overtakes home life. Please also note the feedback with regards the contacts page, termly reports and staff being available. Alternately reports are very clear as to how children are performed at school and these are given each term, as well as the opportunity for the informal discussions throughout.
