Returning to School Update

The children of critical workers and those who are vulnerable can return to school tomorrow if they have booked. You will appreciate the importance of booking so that we can ensure we have the appropriate number of staff at school and all required organisation. I hope yesterday's Zoom meetings were useful for those that are able to join and the question and answer sessions helped you understand how Remote Learning at Krishna Avanti Primary School will work. We will be putting the questions and answers and I will provision on the website very soon. A few key points that may be useful prior to tomorrow's start:

- The day at school start at 08:00 and finish at 14:45. Children can be dropped off up to 15 minutes before 08:00 where they will go to their year. Children staying beyond 14:45 will take part in various activities.
- For dropping off and picking up parents should drive around the field to the gates. Children arriving later than 08:00 should be dropped off at the main door.
- Children do not need uniform.
- Children may bring one piece of fruit and their water bottle.
- Live lessons will start via Google Classroom as per the timetable below for those children at home and school. This might not happen exactly as per the timetable on Thursday and Friday this week but lessons will be set.
- Work on Google Classroom will be available from 18:00 the day before for those children in Foundation Two and Key Stage One. It will be available from 21:00 for those children in Key Stage Two. The need for parents to prepare anything should not be necessary as the live learning will involve the teacher introducing and explaining the lesson.
- Collective Worship will start remotely next Monday, from 08:30.

We appreciate that there is a lot to take in at the moment. As explained on the Zoom calls, Thursday and Friday will be more flexible and relaxed as we ensure everybody has their passwords, appropriate devices and have questions answered.

I hope the above is somewhat reassuring. We look forward to seeing the children whether in person or remotely and we will keep communicating to you.
