TOP TIPS FOR HELPING YOUR CHILD TO READ:

- Allow children time to break down unfamiliar words into units of sound and then encourage children to string these sounds together to create the word.
- Encourage your child to point out any focus phonics when they are used.
- Read through the book more than once to grow confidence.
- Ask simple questions about the text to assess understanding.
- Encourage children to use illustrations as prompts.

“Hello?” said Chloe into the cave. Her voice echoed along the walls. “Hello?” she said again.






There was something a bit farther into the cave. Chloe had to see what it was! She was so afraid, her tummy began to hurt. She took a deep breath and stepped in.

Chloe's day at the beach turns into a trip to an underwater town full of Christmas and merpeople. What will she get up to and who will she meet?

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
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
