Costa Rica means 'rich coast'. The country got its name because of the 800 miles of coastline between the Pacific and Caribbean coasts.

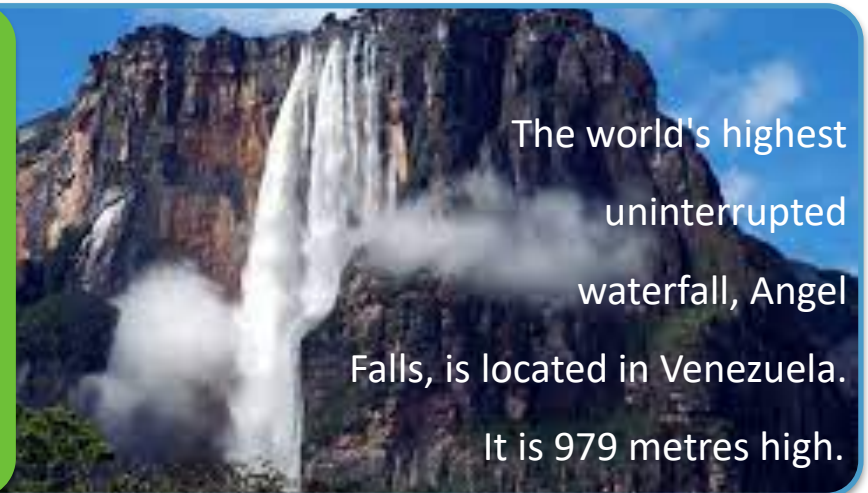


Go explore...
