In 2005 a software error, related to a system upgrade, halted stock and bond trading on the Tokyo Stock Exchange. The glitch was the most serious to hit the exchange since 1999, when floor trading was scrapped so that an all-electronic trading system could be installed.

A computer is not as powerful as the human brain. If there were such a computer, it would have processed 38 thousand trillion operations per second and stored more than 3580 terabytes of memories.
