In 1970, during the 5th Rugby League World Cup: Australia beat Great Britain 12 – 7.

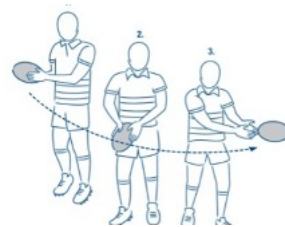


Did you know...
