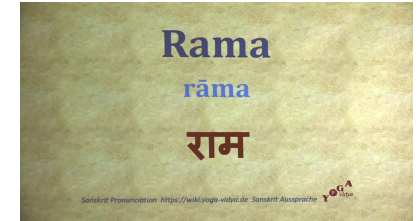
On this day...
