On this day...

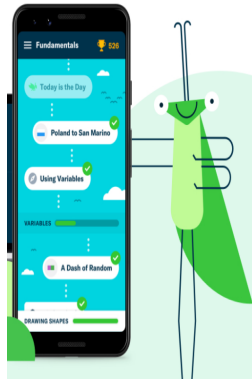
in 1962, NASA launched the active repeater communication satellite, Relay I, from Cape Canaveral. Relay I's mission was primarily experimental, but it was used for some notable events. On November 22, 1963 it was the first satellite to broadcast television from the United States to Japan, the announcement of the assassination of John F. Kennedy.

Did you know...

Not only do you blink less when you are observing a computer screen, but reading from a monitor also slows you down! During everyday life, people normally blink at a rate of twenty times per minute but when put in front of a computer, that number drops way down to seven times per minute!
