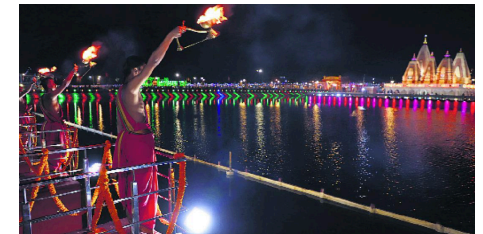
Go explore...
