The Procedure for all year groups

In planning for our children to remain at school we have taken every reasonable precaution to reduce the risk of reproduction, should any children have the coronavirus. We will also update our plans inline with any new guidelines and advice. The following is the agreed procedure, as of the date above and must be followed by all staff, children, parents and visitors to the site of Krishna Avanti Primary School, Leicester.

1. Parents continue to drop children off at the gate and refrain from entering the playground to minimise contact. Children will be supervised on the courtyard and tennis court area and start to enter school from 08:00, enabling distancing whilst spending time in outdoor areas as much as possible. At home-time, classes have a designated pick up point to maintain the class group and working with the one-way system for parents.
2. Children from each class will remain with their class for all lessons and other activities, where reasonably possible. Year groups, whilst sharing the same lunchtimes and large spaces, will sit in class groups to minimise the risk of spread.
3. Parents are encouraged to use Lateral Flow Tests (LFTs) twice per week for the children, to help identify asymptomatic children and where positive, inform the school office.
4. Teaching Assistants will support a limited number of year groups in lessons, breaks to limit staff members moving across year groups.
5. Children within a class will mix. It is our belief that to try to get our young children (even Year 6) to remain apart and not touch is both extremely difficult to do and socially and emotionally damaging. As such, it must be understood that children within a class will not be socially distancing as we have become used to in public. Classrooms will be organised to best suit all needs.
6. The mixing of children across classes within the same year group will be limited, as reasonably possible.
7. No parents to enter the school building.
8. On days with physical education, children must come to school in physical education kit for the day.
9. Children may bring one piece of fruit for break. No crisps, chocolates, Tupperware tubs or similar. A water bottle is also required.
10. Shared cloakrooms to be carefully managed to minimise the occurrence of large groups of children from different classes congregating in the same space





at the same time.

11. Only two year groups per time in the Worship Hall for lunch. This allows more than ample distancing. The year groups to enter together, supporting the organisation of space in all indoor and outdoor areas.
12. Lunches and breaks will have slight staggers to enable every class to have ample space whilst eating and when playing outside.
13. There will be no whole school Worship nor assemblies. These will be limited to two year groups in a ventilated hall and spaced.
14. A cleaner continues to be employed to be on site all day to clean various areas around school, such as touch points.
15. We will continue to use Google Classroom where useful, for example, homework.
16. Parents sending children to school by default, are confirming that no member of the family/ household has or has recently had any symptoms and have not tested positive using a LFT.
17. Those children that need to isolate will have work set on Google Classroom and where possible, have access to live lessons.

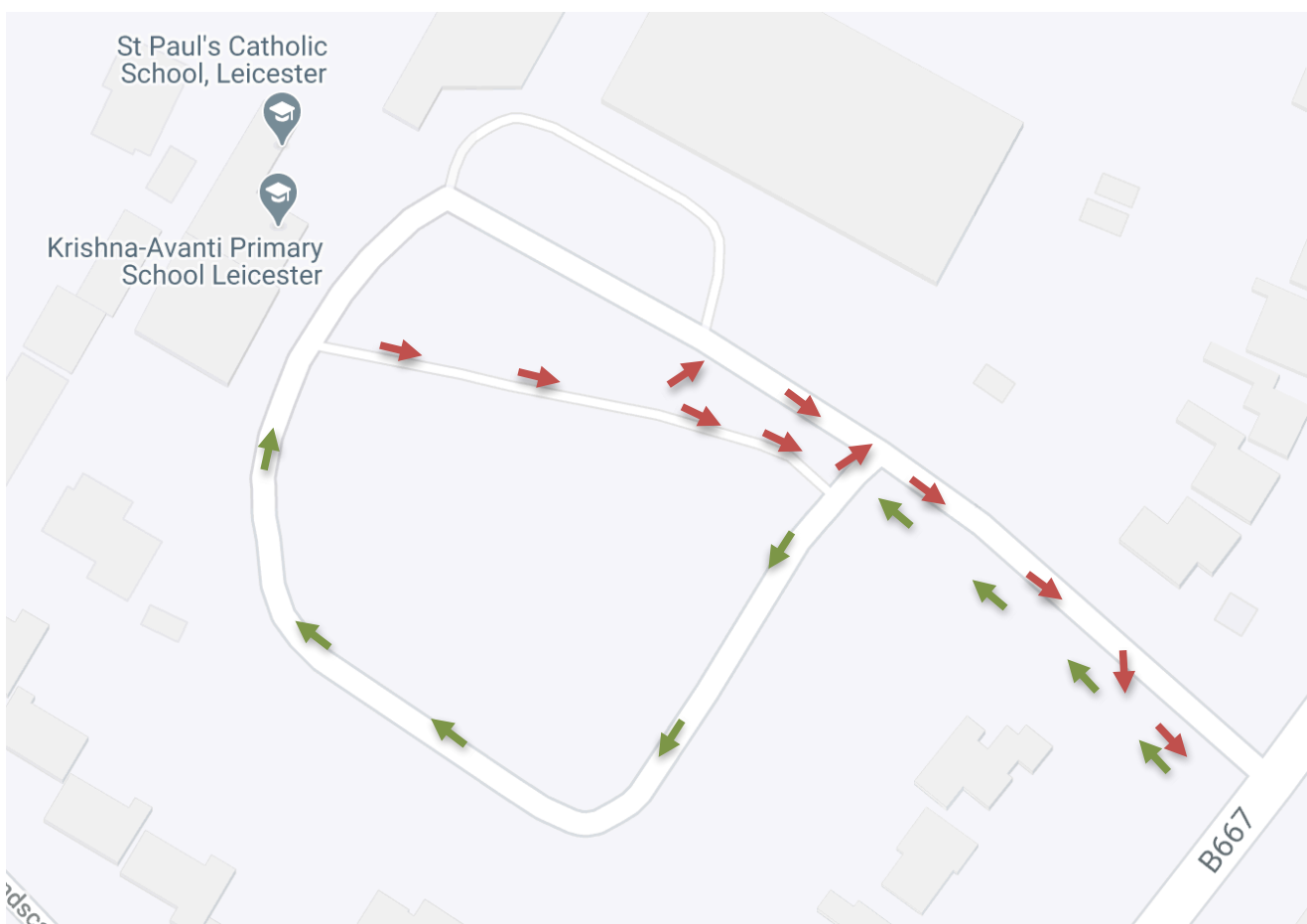
