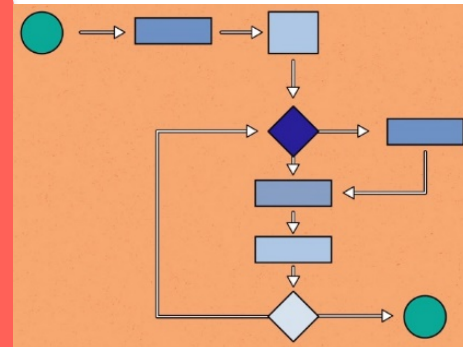

Computers work through special instructions called **algorithms**. If there is even a slightest error in an algorithm, the computer won't be able to complete a task.

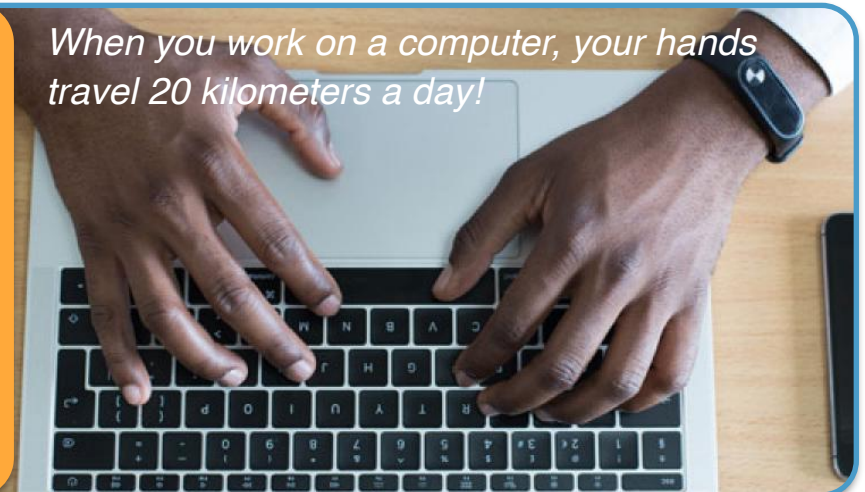
Go explore...
